Surf Payroll to BrightPay: Powering Aylish Morrissey & Co's payroll services







### Surf Payroll to BrightPay: Why the switch?

Aylish Morrissey & Co started using Surf Payroll at the beginning of 2022, before moving to BrightPay the following year. Originally using Sage, they opted to make the move to Surf Payroll, in search of a cloud-based payroll option. While stating Surf Payroll helped her meet her clients' needs, Aylish noted restrictive reporting capabilities and a lack of features as key reasons why she began searching for another payroll software to move to, ultimately making the switch to BrightPay at the beginning of the 2023 tax year.
