- > Cloud service providers, such as Microsoft Azure, provide the cloud platforms where the data is stored
- > Cloud encrypts data to ensure only those granted permission can access your data
- > Cloud provides better controls and permissions, such as multi-factor authentication

- > Cloud acts as a disaster recovery plan, saving data automatically
- > 75% of small businesses don't have a disaster recovery plan
- > Cloud makes it so you will never lose a document again




